Update on State annual training

Registrar will institute satellite absentee voting sites beginning this September. Will decide between 3 and 7 locations. At this time satellite precincts are only authorized for the Presidential election.

Absentee voting begins September 23, 2016.

Dates to be set during September meeting of the board

Chris Williams will assist in office to prepare for November presidential Presidential election.

Dates set for poll workers and voting machine training at September meeting. Mock elections will be part of this years training.

¾ of the voters cards have been scanned and expect to complete the task by next week. All cards are backed up and stored at VRAS.

Website has been updated.

Jason has met with several civic organizations to explain voting process and how the Registrar's office works. Will be meeting with other

civic organizations prior to November election.

Pins for Poll workers have been ordered.

Registrar will order 10 signs to mark voting precincts.

There will be several referendums on the Presidential ballot.

Attempting to implement the use of Pages for all elections. A separate training will be held for this initiative.
